Rules & Conditions of Entry:

1. The organisers, show staff and owners of the land will accept no responsibility for any damages or accident to any person, animal or property whatsoever and it shall be a condition of entry that no claim be brought against any person in any way connected with the show.
2. Safety helmets to current British Standard must be worn by anyone mounted on the showground.
3. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry, cancel or alter classes. The decisions of the judges are final on all matters and are not open to negotiation.
4. Canter and lunging only allowed in designated areas.
5. No stallions will be allowed to enter or any horse or pony under 4 years of age.
6. Competitors are asked to clear away any hay, droppings or litter left by their horses/horseboxes from the field before leaving the Show.
7. All dogs are to be kept on leads.
8. Any person deemed, in the opinion of the organisers, to be mistreating an animal will be ordered to leave the showground immediately.
